As the political arm of the United Nations, DPPA plays a leading role in conflict prevention, mediation, and electoral assistance in the Middle East. Today's volatile environment demands an even more agile UN response, but regular budget resources cannot meet the urgency or scale required.

Against the backdrop of multiple interlocking crises in the Middle East, DPPA seeks enhanced support through the MYA to continue providing impactful mediation, political analysis, and strategic engagement across the region. **With \$3 million in earmarked contributions for our work on the Middle East**, we will provide strategic support to the Secretary-General, special political missions, and other non-mission settings in the region.

Our priority is to advance our good offices and provide diplomatic and mediation support to partners on the ground. DPPA leads UN political and mediation efforts in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, Syria, and Yemen and oversees special political missions in these areas. Through the Office of the Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process (UNSCO), we will support efforts toward a return to the ceasefire while working closely with all partners to advance a viable path toward recovery and reconstruction in Gaza, a just and lasting peace in the Middle East and the realization of the two-State solution. Our support to the political transition in Syria through the offices of the Special Envoy on Syria will be instrumental in ensuring that the transition leads to sustainable peace, justice, and inclusivity in Syria. The Mediation Support Unit and Standby Team of Senior Mediation Advisors will continue to facilitate inclusive dialogue, national reconciliation, and political transitions across the region.

Inclusivity remains at the heart of successful political, constitution drafting, national dialogue, and transition processes. With earmarked contributions for the Middle East, DPPA and our Envoys will be able to continue their work to ensure that **women, youth and civil society** are at the table and can feed into decision-making.
