As the political arm of the United Nations, DPPA is responsible for shaping the UN's response to the world's most pressing political crises, including in Ukraine. Today's dynamic environment demands an even more agile UN approach, but regular budget resources alone cannot meet the urgency or scale required. **With \$800,000 in earmarked contributions for our work on Ukraine**, we will be better equipped to access conflict-affected areas, conduct fact-finding, and provide analysis and political capacity to UN actors on the ground and at Headquarters.

DPPA remains at the forefront of supporting the Secretary-General with **in-depth information and analysis** on the war in Ukraine. The complexities of the war in Ukraine demand nuanced understanding and timely, accurate and fact-based reporting to inform actions by the UN and its partners. Earmarked funding will support DPPA's capacity to provide **comprehensive analysis and surge expertise** to the Secretary-General, UN principals, and Member States. This includes identifying opportunities for the Organization to further support long-term peace efforts, in line with the UN Charter, international law and relevant resolutions.

Additional funding for our **support to diplomatic efforts for peace** in Ukraine is also needed. Staff travel to and within the region to engage with Ukrainian government stakeholders, other partners and Member States is essential in allowing the UN to adapt quickly to shifting diplomatic opportunities and ensuring our engagement remains responsive and informed.

DPPA's **Liaison Office in Kyiv** remains instrumental in **maintaining open communication** with national stakeholders, the diplomatic community and international organizations, ensuring the availability of **the UN's good offices** to facilitate dialogue. Earmarked funding will sustain this presence, which is a lifeline for ongoing, sensitive **political engagement and situational awareness** that guides the UN response.

Building on DPPA's earlier work, enhanced funding will allow us to continue engaging effectively with Ukrainian **women civil society actors** and support their active role in discussions around sustainable peace and recovery. Funding is also needed for DPPA's efforts to promote Ukraine's priorities for **national unity, resilience, and social cohesion** through targeted programmatic activities.
